



RoHS Policy

The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012 (SI 2012/3032) as amended

These regulations restrict the use of hazardous substances including some heavy metals and certain flame retardants in a number of categories of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) and ban the placing on the market of new EEE containing more than an agreed level of restricted substances.

Producers of EEE within the scope of the regulation are responsible for ensuring that their products meet the requirements of it.

Locate Supplies have a duty to comply with the above legislation if any of our customers buy material from us that is then subsequently used in the production of Electrical and Electronic Equipment.

In order to comply, Locate Supplies regularly contacts our suppliers to confirm that where relevant, the % weight of the listed substances in the products supplied to us complies with the regulation requirements, or to advise if this is not the case:

- Lead (0.1%)
- Mercury (0.1%)
- Cadmium (0.01%)
- Hexavalent Chromium (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%)
